APPLICANT: PROCTER

- *Application date:* January 2010

DESCRIPTION OF PACKAGING:

- *Brand name:* Lénor Coup de Foudre (red bottle),
Lénor Nuit étoilée (violet bottle),
Lénor Soupçon d'élégance (black bottle),
- *Shape:* Rectangular based bottle – Marking
- *Volume:* 750 ml, 1 L, 1.5 L



MARKET: Household care products

MATERIALS:

- Body: PET monolayer
- Cap: PP
- Label: OPP
- Ink: for rotogravure printing
- Glue: Single line self-adhesive

TECHNICAL NOTICE:

This packaging, coloured red, violet and black respectively, was assessed in the context of the coloured PET stream.

Although, given the single gluing line, the quantity of glue is small, COTREP recommends testing its washability.

As stated in General Notice FT 21, the PP label does not disrupt the recycling of PET bottles.

The colouring of the bottle bodies has been assessed as recommended in General Notice FT33 "PET Colourings" and, at the tested concentrations:

- The packaging does not disrupt the main recycling streams for fibre applications currently available in Europe.
- The packaging significantly disrupts strapping and bottle applications. It will therefore not systematically be recycled within these applications, since it is refused by some recyclers.

COTREP therefore recommends modifying this packaging so that it is compatible with all PET bottle recycling applications.
